

- Distributed Energy NOFA 07-01
 - Eligible Technologies include biomass methane
 - Max grant at 25% of the project cost
 - Max award \$100,000

State of Ohio

- Biomass Waste to Energy RFP
 - Being prepared now for spring 09 release
 - Looking for shovel ready project (s) 24 months to completion
 - Max award \$500,000
 - Multiple output options
 - Grid connected
 - Thermal energy
 - Methane gas
